Anadil Hossain has a finger on the pulse of Bollywood's popularity overseas. She is a New York-based film producer and founder of the international production house Dillywood. She was born in the United States to Bangladeshi parents and grew up in Dhaka and London, studying film and American studies from the University of East Anglia. Hossain has worked with top directors to bring some of the most successful films of the last six years to an international market such as Karan Johar's Kal Ho Na Ho and Kabhie Alvida Naa Kehna, Ashutosh Gowariker's Swades, Rakeysh Mehra's Delhi 6 and Mira Nair's The Namesake. She also worked with Gowariker on What's Your Rashee, the Priyanka Chopra starrer that premiered at the Toronto International Film Festival in 2009. With her continued work across continents. Hossain has become a household name in the entertainment industry on both sides of the pond, consulting for major US studios like Fox Searchlight and Disney International, as well as government organizations to build stronger relations between the East and West film industries. Some companies have tried to tempt her into leading their Indian productions, but Hossain wants to concentrate on developing Dillywood. She is producing two exciting films this year - Fair Game directed by Doug Liman and starring A-listers Naomi Watts and Sean Penn, and The Rebound with director Bart Freundlich featuring Catherine Zeta-Jones and Justin Bartha.
